RELIEF ...

Meeting immediate needs

CRISIS SERVICES - Temporary assistance to families in crisis. Services including obtaining birth certificates toiletry items, assistance with utility shut-off, work boots for employment.

CAREGIVERS - Provides services to the elderly (62 and older) in including transportation to medical appts., friendly visits, outings.

CHRISTIAN AUTO REPAIR - Providing vehicle maintenance of tune-ups and minor repairs to assist families in maintaining reliable transportation.

CHRISTMAS SHOP - FAMILIES One of a kind program for parents to *choose* gifts for their children while giving back to the community through volunteering or other contributions.

CHRISTMAS SHOP – SENIORS Providing seniors with toiletries, and gifts of much needed items.

TAX CLINIC – Free tax preparation for seniors and low-income families. IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program.

EDUCATION ...

Providing tools and resources to broaden knowledge and promote positive change.

INDIVIDUAL & FAMILY CLASSES

GETTING AHEAD - A ten-week program for individuals and families to investigate the hidden rules of social class and learn about the resources necessary to support their goals of self- sustainability.

FINANCIAL SENSE I & II – A six-week faith-based money management class program designed for those with lower income.

GETTING AHEAD WHILE GETTING OUT – A ten-week program for those incarcerated assisting with reentry.

PARENTING CLASSES – for parents of hard to raise children including those with ADD/ADHD, teens and classes for single-moms

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

PIH POVERTY SIMULATIONS – simulates a month in the life of a family living in poverty.

BRIDGES OUT OF POVERTY - Explore poverty, hidden rules of class, and invites social action to eliminate poverty.

TACTICAL COMMUNICATIONS – for first responders - effective interactions with citizens from diverse economic backgrounds

DEVELOPMENT ...

Supporting the journey from crisis based living to a secure and stable lifestyle.

PARTNER FAMILIES -

Persons actively engaged in an Education or Development Program at Partners in Hope. These relationships are created for long term results.

STAYING AHEAD -

A PIH resource development and goal setting program based on the Getting Ahead curriculum. Individuals and families along with their children participate in a weekly group that provides support and education from staff, community professionals, volunteers and each other as they work to accomplish their goals.
